Varietals: Sauvignon Blanc, Cabernet Shiraz



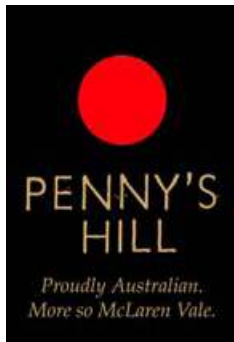
Organic Vignerons Australia

- OVA wines are all certified organic, award winning wines from small family owned farms in South Australia that ensure attention to detail and maximum quality.
- Organic certification involves a 3 year period with a registered certifier. All OVA growers are certified by BFA (Biological Farmers Australia) or NASAA (National Australian Sustainable Agriculture Association).
- To maintain certification annual property inspections are carried out. The system works well in Australia due to strict adherence to standards set out by the certifiers.
- Varietals: Viognier, Merlot, Shiraz, Cabernet and Sauvignon

Established in 1988, Penny's Hill produces top quality estate-grown wines. Sourcing grapes from vineyards located on the foothills east of McLaren Vale Penny's Hill is building an enviable reputation for high quality, concentrated wines with excellent regional expression.

1997 saw the release of the very first wine under the Penny's Hill label, a 1995 Shiraz, under the distinctive « red dot » packaging.

Attention to detail in the vineyard and winery ensures wines under the Penny's Hill label, made by winemaker Benn Riggs, are fruit driven, complex, well-balanced and show an excellent use of the very best oak.

Varietals: Chardonnay, Viognier, Verdelho, Shiraz, Cabernet, Merlot
